- Did you know PCOHC/NEOTRA helps maintain the Equestrian Camp ground area by removing garbage, clearing branches/trees, blowing leaves, and mounting blocks?

- Did you know that in an average year, 285 hours is spent on trail maintenance and completed by ONLY 20 club members & volunteers?
